**BEFORE USING**

- Remove surface dirt from timber with a broom or brush.

**APPLICATION:**

- Mix one part of Valspar Deck Wash to nine parts water.
  - Apply a generous coat of the solution with a garden sprayer or watering can and lightly scrub the wetted deck with a soft bristle brush, broom or mop. Do not use a wire brush or stiff bristled brush.
- WARNING:** This cleaner will cause surfaces to become slippery until rinsed off.
- Rinse or hose off with fresh water.
  - Greasy or very dirty decks may require a repeat wash.
  - Clean equipment with water.
  - Do not use this product on freshly coated decks as it may damage them.

For best results, coated timber should be left for at least two weeks before cleaning.
